

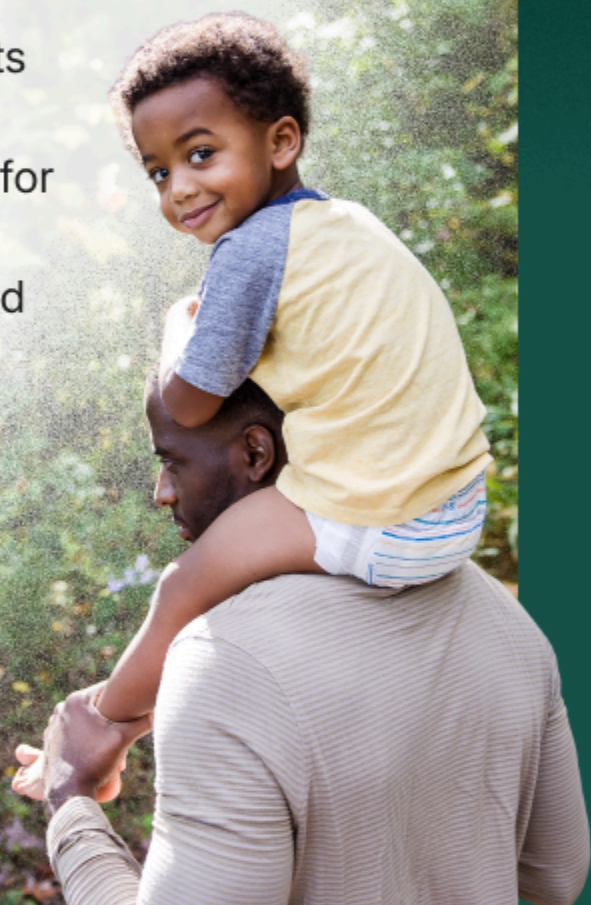

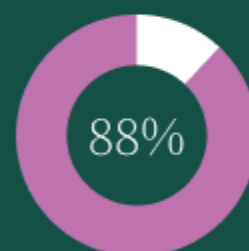
What Are Medicaid Income Limits?

Medicaid income limits are the most you can make and still qualify for Medicaid. Each state sets different Medicaid income limits.



Did you know?

About half of all U.S. children — roughly 38 million — receive coverage through Medicaid or the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP). CHIP helps low-income families who earn too much for Medicaid but cannot afford private insurance.



More than 88% of children eligible for Medicaid or CHIP are enrolled.

Can My Child Qualify for Medicaid?

For your child to qualify for Medicaid, you must meet these requirements:

- Live in the state
- Meet state income limits
- Insured children must be under age 19

Note: Medicaid requirements vary by state.



In most states, children up to age 19 with a family income of up to

\$80,000

in a family of four may qualify for Medicaid or CHIP.
