Careers *Forced* to Take a Back Seat

Over **1 in 2** caregivers have reduced their hours at work just to provide care.

11% had to leave their jobs entirely.

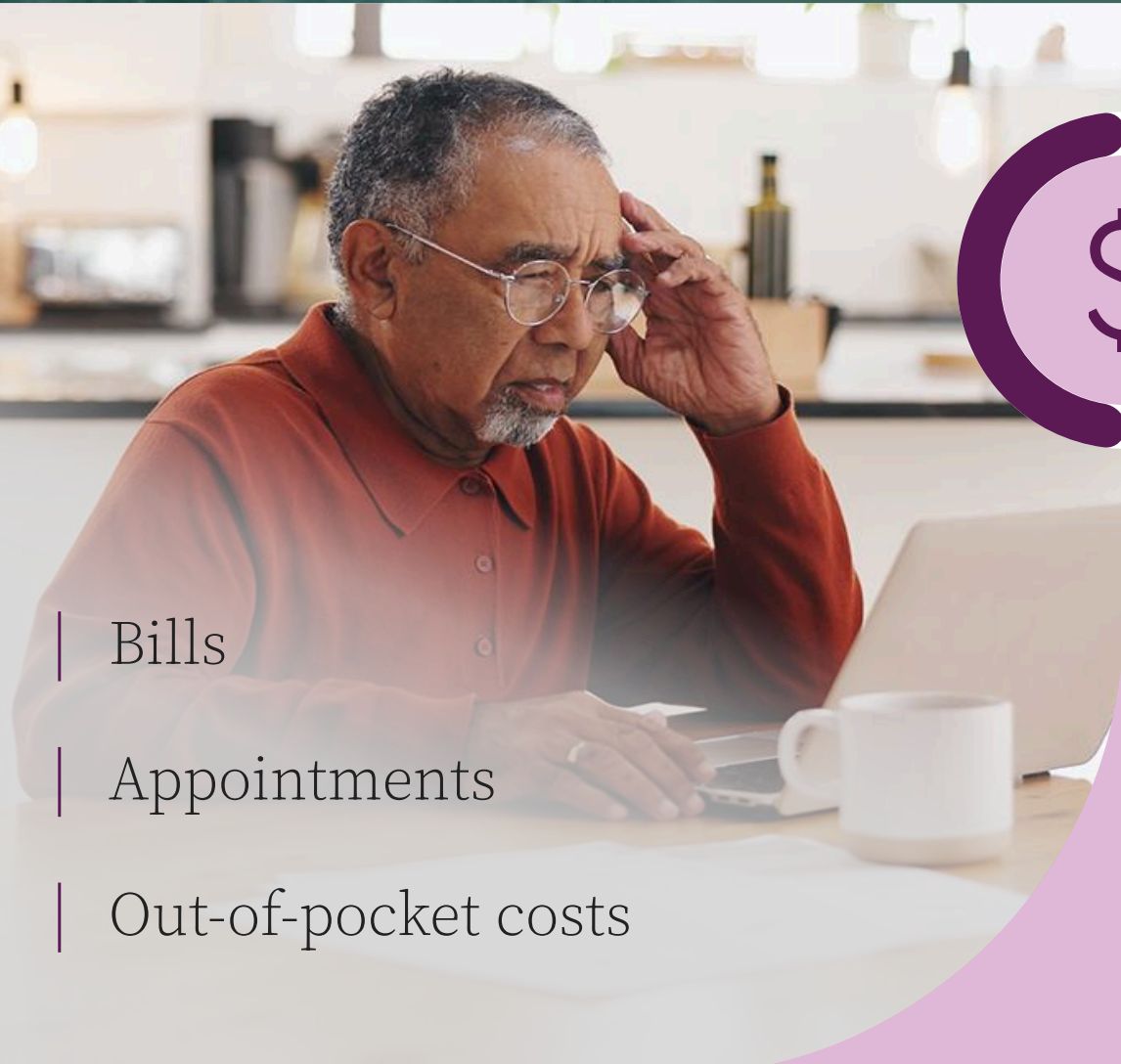


Caregivers lose their primary source of income when they need it *most.*

60% of caregivers are hit with a heavy monthly

Spending between \$100 and \$500 out-of-pocket just to afford basic bladder control supplies.

Nearly half

of caregiving households are forced to **stretch less than \$75,000 a year** across basic living expenses and mounting medical costs.

12% are left to cover these endless bills on less than **\$25,000.**
