What Is CHIP?

The Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) is a government health insurance program that provides health coverage for children and pregnant women on low income.

What's Covered?

- Routine check-ups
- Immunizations and vaccines
- Healthcare provider visits
- Prescriptions
- Dental and vision care
- Inpatient and outpatient hospital care
- Labs and x-ray services
- Emergency services

Who's Eligible?

- Children 19 and younger on low income
- Pregnant women on low income

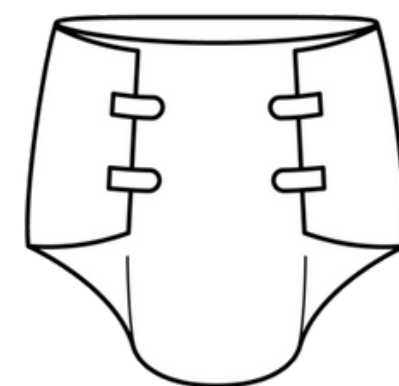
