



Q2 Is your household income less than \$25,000 (if single income) or \$50,000 (if two person income)?








Q6 On average, how many dollars do you spend on diapers per week?




Q8 Do you struggle with affording diapers and/or other incontinence supplies?


Q9 Have you ever had to choose between buying diapers/incontinence supplies and other necessities, such as food, electricity, doctor's visits or transportation?




Q10 How often do you have to choose between diapers and other necessities?










Q13 Have you or an individual in your household who needs diapers ever had to miss activities or experiences due to not having enough diapers or their bladder condition?


Q14 Have you or an individual in your household ever suffered from a more severe complication due to not having enough diapers or resources?


Q15 Do you feel your mental health has been impacted by needing diapers or caring for someone with diapers?




Q17 Have you ever felt any of the below since needing diapers or caring for someone with diapers?


Q18 Has your healthcare provider ever assisted you with acquiringdiapers?



Q20 Do you wish there were more resources available to help navigate caring for someone with a bladder condition?




