

Medications To Treat Urinary Incontinence In Seniors

Anticholinergics

Oxybutynin, Solifenacin, Fesoterodine, Darifenacin, Tolterodine, Trospium

Side Effects: Dry mouth, dizziness, constipation, nausea, Vomiting, headache, blurred vision, reflux, confusion, urinary retention, glaucoma, psychosis, seizures, tachycardia, angioedema

Risk Factors: Caution should be advised for those with dementia, Parkinson's disease, constipation, ulcerative colitis, glaucoma, alcohol use, and GERD

Beta-adrenergics

Mirabegron, Vibegron

Side Effects: Stuffy nose, headache, tachycardia, nausea, elevated blood pressure, uncontrolled hypertension, urinary retention, angioedema

Risk Factors: Uncontrolled hypertension and renal impairment are contraindications
