In order to qualify for incontinence products as an adult through Aeroflow Urology, your patient needs:

- ✓ A Medicaid or other accepted insurance plan.
- ✓ A prescription for incontinence products from you, their healthcare provider.
- ✓ Details concerning the patient's specific diagnosis of incontinence (such as urinary, fecal, stress, etc.)
- ✓ An underlying medical condition or diagnosis that causes incontinence, as outlined in this pamphlet.

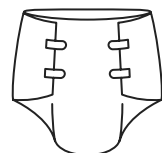

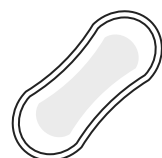
PROTECTIVE UNDERWEAR
